Guest presentation: Dan Phohl thanked the club for the work we completed on the KR2 to prepare it for use as a teaching aid for the Youth Aerospace Program. Dan specifically thanked Bob Schauber for his contributions, which included his work on the KR2, his donation of a Lycoming cylinder and piston and for volunteering to be an instructor. Dan expressed his condolences to Bob's loved-ones and friends.

Dan Oldridge showed us all the modifications that were made to the KR2 to allow its use as a teaching aid. These include modification of the wings so they can be folded when the aircraft is not in use, the installation of struts to hold the wings securely in the up position, installation of a clear panel on the wing to show the aileron cables and pulleys and removal of interior panels and antennas to reveal the control cables and pulleys. Dan demonstrated the installation of Oratex fabric and hot-melt adhesive to cover the gap at the folding wings.

Dan Phohl showed some of the members the flight simulators that will be used for the Youth Aerospace Program.
