Fly-in Details:

Metz Field is located at N 43° 48' 37'' W 080° 26' 07''.

Airstrip Details:

- 1800' x 60' Grass strip oriented 14-32
- 1100' x 45' Grass strip oriented 05-23
- 1525 ft. ASL
- Powerlines at end of 14 (marked with safety balls)
- Keep all circuits to the West of the field to avoid glider activity at Walters Field (York Soaring CPC3)
- Use 123.4 Mhz. when approaching the field
- Caution Four wind turbines one mile to the south

Drive-in Details:

Take Hwy 6 North of Fergus to Nichol Rd 10 and turn right. Go to the Stop sign and turn left onto Jones Baseline. Follow the road around to the right onto Side Road 15. Turn left onto the 3rd Line and go to #7159 on the right side. There is a MACPAT Sign on the workshop.
