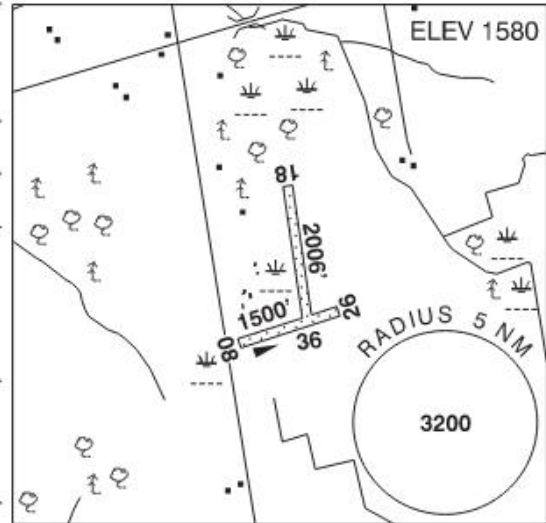

### Fly-in Details:

Roger’s Airstrip coordinates: 43°53'40"N 80°31'07"W

#### Airstrip Details:

- 2006’ x75’ grass strip - oriented N/S (18-36)
- 1500’ x 75’ grass strip - oriented E/W (08-26)
- 1580’ ASL
- Clear approaches both directions
- Use 123.4 MHz when approaching the field
- 7 km. (4 nm.) north of the centre of Arthur
- Follow standard uncontrolled aerodrome procedures

### Drive-in Details:

Take Eliza St. (County Rd 14) north from Arthur. Go 4 km north from the outskirts of Arthur, then turn right onto Line 4. Drive 1.8 km then turn left onto Side Road 3. Roger’s place is 1.6 km on the right (#8837)
